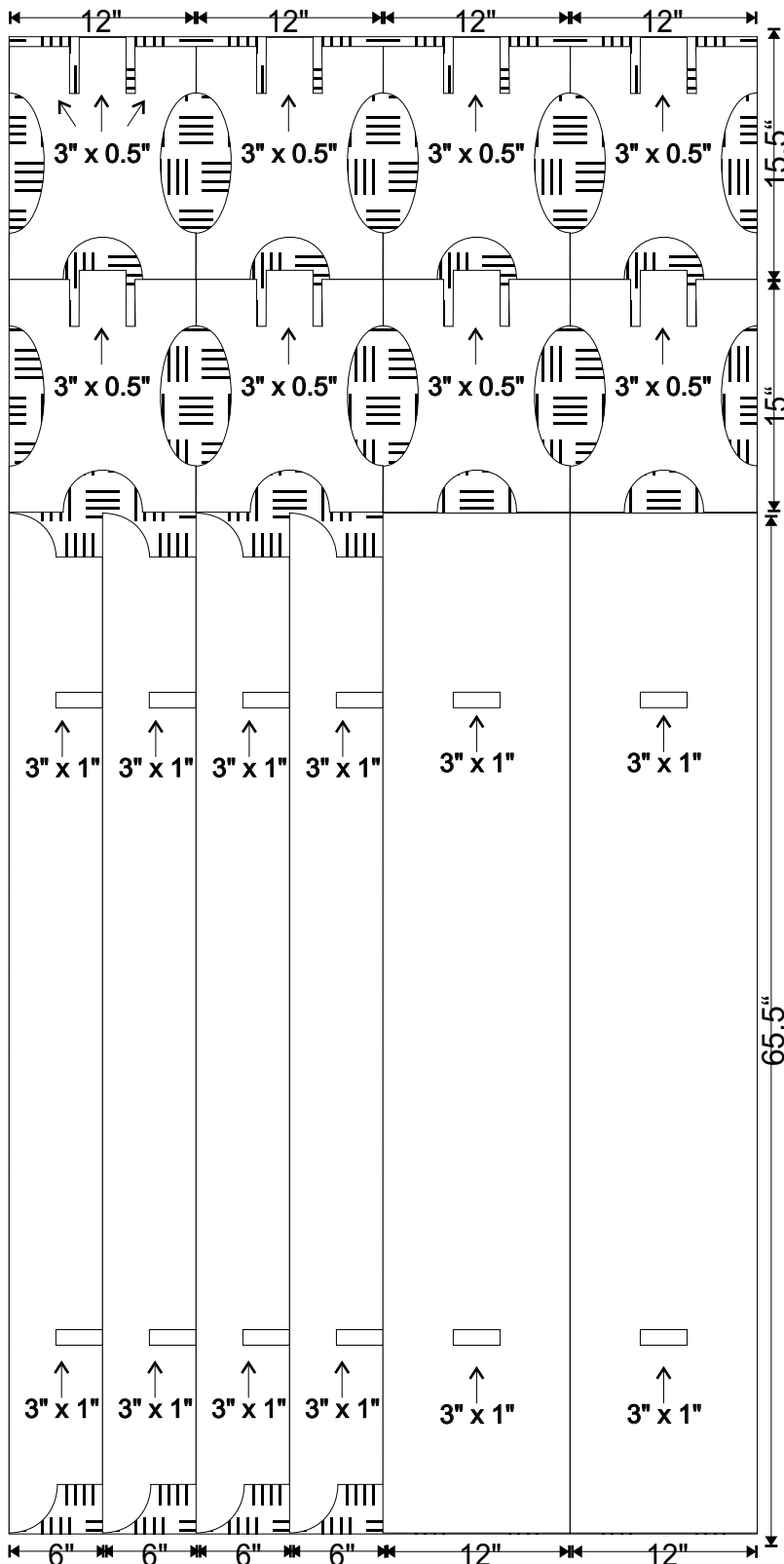


# Medieval Camp Benches From A Sheet of 1/2" Plywood



## Materials:

One 4'x8' sheet of 1/2" plywood  
 Sandpaper  
 Paint, or stain and varnish as desired

## Tools:

Circular saw with plywood blade  
 Jigsaw with wood-cutting blade  
 Drill and bits

## Directions:

1. Mark the plywood for cutting.
2. Cut all pieces and sand edges.  
 Carefully sand the top of the seat.
3. Double the uprights and glue them together to 1" thick.

Tip #1: Glue the uprights *before* cutting the notches and decorative curves.

Tip #2: Remember that the glue adds thickness. Measure the uprights and cut the notches in the other boards to match.

Tip #3: An 11" string on tacks 10" apart makes a nice ellipse for the sides.

4. Paint or stain.
